



The 2014 SustainableUW Festival (green.uw.edu/festival) will be the week of October 20-25. The festival celebrates environmental stewardship and sustainability efforts at the University of Washington, highlighting contributions and leadership efforts across campus as well as providing opportunities for students, faculty and staff to get involved.

The festival builds on the four-year tradition of the UW Sustainability Summit and expands the scope to include programming from partners across campus throughout the week as well as continuing the central events from past Summits.
