


# SUSTAINING WALLACE

Wallace Hall supports the work of The Climate Impacts Group, the Program on the Environment (POE) and the Joint Institute for the Study of the Atmosphere and Ocean (JISAO). POE works to "provide students with a deep understanding of how humans interact with and influence the environment" and "develop skills to address multifaceted environmental challenges." JISAO conducts cutting-edge research in climate, ocean and fishery sciences. The Climate Impacts Group conducts research on "climate variability, climate change, and climate impacts" with an orientation toward using this information in decision-making.
